Outline of Expectations Climate Interactive and En-ROADS Climate Ambassadors

This document establishes the expectations of En-ROADS Climate Ambassadors and Climate Interactive to support each other in fulfilling the goals of the Ambassador program and Climate Interactive's mission and vision. Climate Interactive envisions a thriving world, where greenhouse gas emissions are falling rapidly. We hope to drive effective and equitable action by creating and sharing a range of tools. The En-ROADS Climate Ambassador Program by Climate Interactive aims to train, empower, and support an international network of climate leaders – equipping them with the necessary tools and resources to deliver data-driven insights on cross-sector climate solutions to millions worldwide.

Climate Interactive is dedicated to producing trainings, tools, and other resources which support Ambassadors' understanding and diffusion of the En-ROADS Climate Solutions Simulator through events and conversations about climate solutions, the impacts of climate change, and ways to address the climate challenge equitably. En-ROADS Climate Ambassadors are dedicated to diffusing our tools and resources, leading events, cultivating productive conversations, and encouraging other/future Ambassadors.

En-ROADS Climate Ambassador Agreements

Once you have been accepted as an En-ROADS Climate Ambassador you are accepted for one year. To maintain your Ambassador status in the following years, you are **required to**:

- Facilitate and register at least 2 En-ROADS events, such as the En-ROADS Climate Workshop and the Climate Action Simulation, per year.
- 2. Participate in at least 2 model update webinars, Ambassador meetups, public workshops, training series, or other informative <u>events hosted by Climate</u>

 <u>Interactive or their partners</u> per year.

If these items are outstanding, your Ambassador status will become inactive until you have completed the requirements. You are still welcome to facilitate events at your leisure, but you will eventually be removed from our list of En-ROADS Climate Ambassadors.

As an En-ROADS Climate Ambassador, you are **encouraged to pursue** the following as your time, skills, and connections allow:

- Facilitate En-ROADS events, for members of your communities as well as events open to the general public and for those in need of facilitators.
- Support people interested in hosting or participating in En-ROADS events as well as those hoping to become En-ROADS facilitators themselves. This could include leading events for others, sharing resources and trainings, offering mentorship, and providing co-facilitator opportunities.
- Communicate about your events, En-ROADS, the Ambassador program, and other relevant topics to help spread Climate Interactive's work and grow the program. Additionally, please remember to register all of your events.

Climate Interactive Agreements

In return, Climate Interactive provides content and support to all of the En-ROADS Climate Ambassadors through the means of:

- Creating and providing access to materials, tools, and resources for En-ROADS and associated events to continue developing Ambassadors' knowledge.
- Providing one-on-one support from Climate Interactive staff through different channels such as our support platform, video calls, and community discussion platforms.
- Maintaining an environment to connect and explore questions with other Ambassadors through regular meetups, subgroups, and community knowledge exchange platforms.
- Receiving and considering Ambassador feedback in a timely manner.
- Promoting Ambassadors on our website (if desired) and through social media, and, when available, offering opportunities to lead events, write blog posts, make external partnerships, and participate in sector-specific networks.

Additional Considerations

En-ROADS Climate Ambassadors may refer to themselves as an "En-ROADS Climate Ambassador" or a "Climate Interactive volunteer". You are not to say that you are employed by, or represent Climate Interactive or MIT. While promoting En-ROADS, please do note that "En-ROADS is a tool created by Climate Interactive and the MIT Sustainability Initiative."

Use of En-ROADS is free for both commercial and non-commercial use with proper attribution. All accompanying En-ROADS materials are under a Creative Commons license and can be adapted to fit your needs, as long as you give Climate Interactive credit for the original creation of the materials.

As an En-ROADS Climate Ambassador, there may be times when you are looking to add a logo to an event, resource, or platform. We encourage you to use the <u>En-ROADS logo</u> as needed to describe your work as an En-ROADS Climate Ambassador, promote your events, or in any other settings where relevant. However, please refrain from using the Climate Interactive and MIT Sustainability Initiative logos in circumstances beyond describing the creation of the En-ROADS Simulator and its related materials and programs.

Being an En-ROADS Climate Ambassador does not imply or provide for any compensation from Climate Interactive to En-ROADS Climate Ambassadors. If compensation is offered for an En-ROADS event, for example by a group hosting the event, Ambassadors are welcome to take advantage of this benefit without approval from the Climate Interactive team. If possible, <u>donating</u> 10% of the compensation to Climate Interactive is always appreciated.

Climate Interactive is committed to an inclusive, equitable, and safe environment for everyone. Our Ambassadors are expected to reflect these values as a part of their engagement within and beyond Climate Interactive's network.

Climate Interactive reserves the right to revoke a person's En-ROADS Climate Ambassador status, and any En-ROADS Climate Ambassador can withdraw their names from the Ambassador program by contacting Climate Interactive at any point.
